# Our mission

The Motul Corazón Foundation works to ensure that every young person, regardless of their background, has access to quality training and employment opportunities that match their potential, by helping overcome barriers linked to social and educational inequalities.

The Foundation supports projects that prepare young people for careers in mechanics — across mobility, industry, and recycling sectors — combining hands-on learning with the development of soft skills, in order to foster long-term employability and independence.

These initiatives are aimed at young people under the age of 25 facing educational, social, or economic hardship (school dropout, distance from employment, lack of qualifications, or limited access to training), particularly in regions where opportunities are scarce.

Present in the countries where Motul products are distributed, the Foundation relies on local organizations to provide long-term support to these young people through technical skills development, self-confidence building, and sustainable professional integration.

# How we take action & Get involved alongside us

The Motul Corazón Foundation is built around four guiding principles of action:



## **Strategic targeting**

Supporting young people for whom access to training and employment is a key factor for long-term social and professional integration.



## **Learning through action**

Promoting hands-on educational approaches: workshop practice, real-life production, professional immersion, and direct client interaction.



## **Strong local partnerships**

Working alongside expert local organizations deeply rooted in their communities and able to support young people over the long term.



## **Measurable impact**

Integrating monitoring indicators from the very beginning of each project in order to assess outcomes and ensure the effectiveness and sustainability of the initiatives.

## **Who can submit a project?**

- Public-interest organizations with strong local roots (associations, NGOs, foundations)
- Non-political and non-religious organizations
- Projects located in regions where Motul operates or is represented

## **The project must:**

- Prepare young people for technical professions (mobility, industry, recycling)
- Combine technical training with personal development
- Demonstrate measurable social impact
- Be designed for long-term continuity and encourage co-funding opportunities

## **How does it work?**

1. Verify the project's eligibility
2. Complete the summary application form (objectives, beneficiaries, indicators, etc.)
3. Review process conducted by the Foundation
4. Presentation to the Executive Committee
5. Decision on whether the project will receive support

# The executive committee

The Motul Corazón Foundation relies on a structured governance model that ensures transparency, rigor, humility, and long-term impact. As a foundation operating under the aegis of the Fondation de France, it benefits from a secure legal framework and oversight that guarantees its actions remain aligned with the public interest.



## **A clear role**

The Executive Committee is the Foundation's decision-making body. It defines the strategic direction, selects the projects to support, approves the allocation and amount of grants, and ensures that all initiatives remain aligned with the Foundation's mission. The Committee meets three to four times a year.



## **Expert governance**

Made up of Motul representatives, qualified external members, and a representative of the Fondation de France, the Committee ensures an independent, rigorous, and consistent assessment of each project. With two core priorities: making the best possible use of resources and delivering lasting social impact.

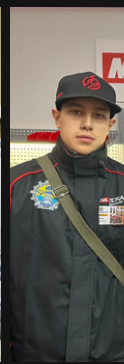


## Young people, tools, and life paths

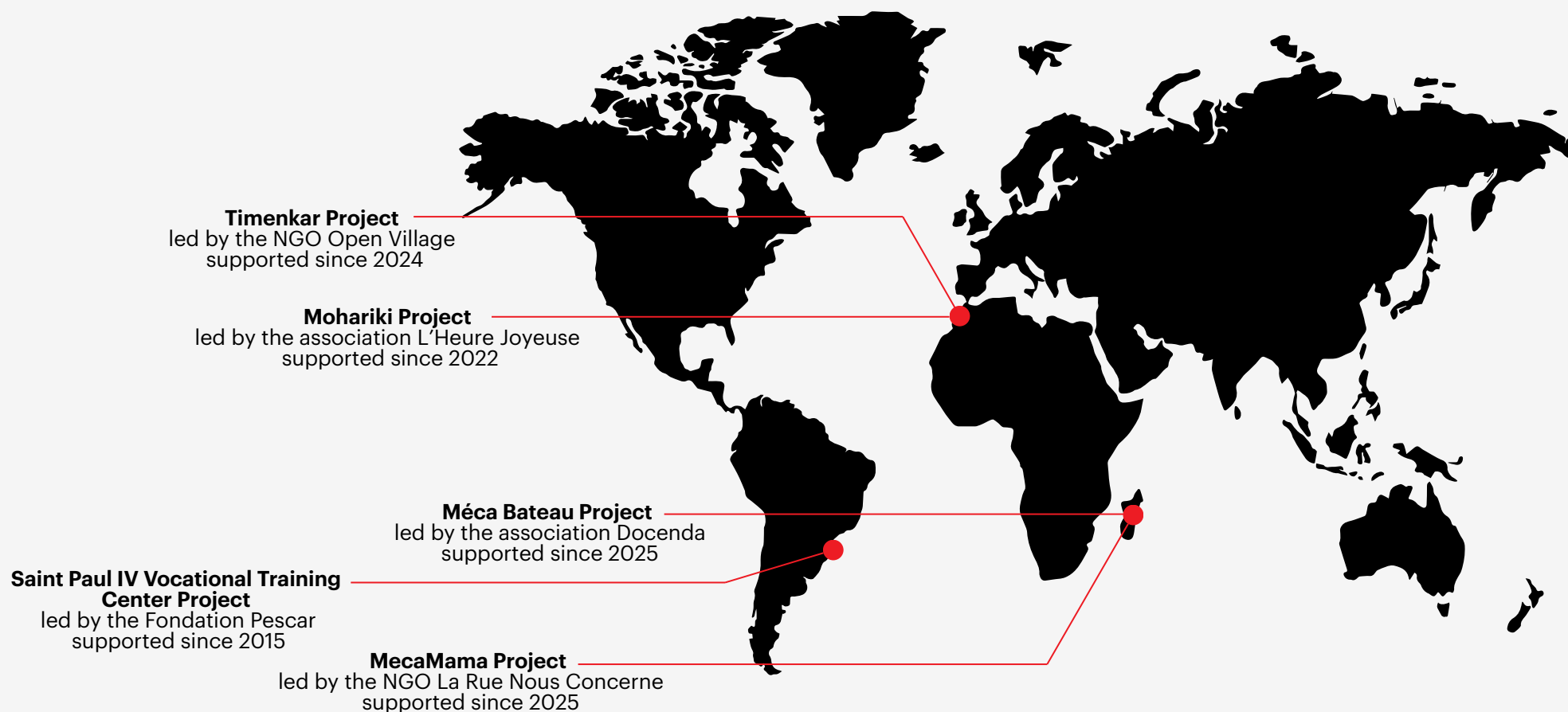
Since 2011, the Motul Corazón Foundation has supported more than 120 projects around the world — from Burkina Faso to Ukraine, from Cambodia to Argentina, and from Madagascar to France.

Very different contexts, yet one shared conviction: when a young person learns a hands-on profession and is supported by the right people, they regain confidence and can transform their future.

The following pages present a selection of projects supported by the Motul Corazón Foundation, illustrating the diversity of regions, partners, and approaches. Each one reflects a common commitment: giving young people the “tools for life” and opening up new possibilities for their future.



# Our projects in Africa and South America




# Mohariki Project

led by the association L'Heure Joyeuse 

Vocational training in automotive maintenance

Partnership: 2022

Casablanca, Morocco 

Motul representative: Olivier De Pennart and his team

Led by the association L'Heure Joyeuse, this project aims to support young people classified as NEETs (Not in Employment, Education or Training) living in underprivileged neighborhoods of Casablanca.

The program combines guidance, technical training in automotive maintenance, and employment support in order to promote the long-term professional integration of young people.

## Intervention model

The project is based on a structured support pathway including:

- outreach, reception, and guidance for young people from disadvantaged neighborhoods;
- training in core professional skills;
- technical training in automotive maintenance;
- employment support and post-placement follow-up.

The objective is to facilitate access to sustainable employment for young people while addressing the needs of the local automotive sector.

## Key figures

### Training Program

- Training in mechanical maintenance
- Curriculum combining general education and vocational training
- Development of technical and soft skills

### Beneficiaries

- 48 graduates/direct beneficiaries
- 144 indirect beneficiaries (families)
- Positive impact on the local economic ecosystem and automotive workshops



## Support from the Motul Corazón Foundation

The Motul Corazón Foundation supports the project in order to strengthen technical training and the professional integration of young people in the mechanical sector.

Its support notably contributes to improving training conditions and developing initiatives that promote the acquisition of professional skills and access to employment. In addition to this support, Motul's local teams in Morocco provide on-site guidance to help young people value their experience — both personally and professionally — as part of their integration into the job market.

This partnership plays an essential role in the personal development and empowerment of these young people.

# Timenkar Project

## led by the NGO Open Village

Training in bicycle trades and sustainable mobility

Partnership: 2024  
Timenkar, Morocco 🇲🇦  
Motul representative: Michel Rivoire

Led by the NGO Open Village, the project aims to improve mobility for young people living on the Timenkar plateau (14 villages) while developing local technical skills.

In this isolated rural area, where reaching middle school can require up to a 90-minute walk, the project provides a practical solution: shared bicycles and a dedicated maintenance space to facilitate access to education and strengthen young people's independence.

### Intervention model

The project is based on a three-phase approach:

- refurbishing bicycles in partnership with a specialized organization;
- building a workshop using local materials for storage and repairs;
- implementing a bicycle lending system for young people and tourists.

The initiative encourages local ownership of the project and the creation of income-generating activities through tourism.

### Key figures

Training Program

- 40 refurbished bicycles
- Training in bicycle mechanics and ecotourism

Beneficiaries

- 227 young people (aged 12–18) from 14 villages
- Direct impact on families and the local community
- Support for education, particularly for young girls

The Motul Corazón Foundation supports the project in order to strengthen access to training and promote the independence of young people living in an isolated rural area. Its support helps create a dedicated bicycle mechanics space, develop technical skills, and encourage professional integration through income-generating activities. This partnership helps connect mobility, education, and local development by providing a sustainable solution to school accessibility challenges while opening up new economic opportunities for young people.

# Méca Bateau Project

## led by the Docenda association

Vocational training in boat mechanics



Partnership: 2025  
Anjanjano, Madagascar 🇲🇵  
Motul representative: Stéphane Mathieu

The project aims to provide middle school students living in a highly isolated area, where access to training is limited, with an introduction to various trades in order to develop practical skills and open up new professional opportunities.

These workshops allow young people to discover several fields such as mechanics, sewing, IT, crafts, and cooking.

### Intervention model

The program is based on:

- weekly vocational workshops;
- the involvement of trainers coming from Nosy Be;
- hands-on learning in small groups;
- exposure to different professions and practical know-how.

The workshops enable students to acquire concrete skills and discover local professional opportunities.

### Key figures

Training Program

- 2 groups per week
- 6 to 12 students per workshop
- All students participate in 2 workshops
- 5 workshops offered

### Support from the Motul Corazón Foundation

The Motul Corazón Foundation supported the creation of the boat mechanics workshop by notably financing trainer-related expenses, a full set of tools, and the equipment required for the training. It also contributes to the boat transportation costs needed each week to bring the trainers to the site.

This support allows students to discover the fundamentals of outboard engine mechanics — a particularly valuable skill in a region where transportation and economic activity largely depend on maritime travel.

# MecaMama Project

## led by the NGO La Rue Nous Concerne

Training women in motorcycle and automotive mechanics

Partnership: 2025  
Antananarivo, Madagascar 🇲🇵  
Motul representative: Stéphane Mathieu

The MecaMama project aims to train women living in precarious situations in mechanical trades — a sector that plays a key role in urban mobility in Madagascar.

In a predominantly male industry, the program enables participants to acquire technical skills and strengthen their economic independence through a comprehensive approach combining technical training, psychosocial support, and professional integration.

### Intervention model

The project is based on:

- technical training in automotive and motorcycle mechanics;
- hands-on workshop learning;
- support toward employment or entrepreneurship;
- psychosocial support;
- post-training follow-up for beneficiaries.

These initiatives enable participants to develop professional skills and gain access to new economic opportunities.

### Key figures

Beneficiaries

- 50 young women direct beneficiaries
- 200 indirect beneficiaries
- 37 work-study beneficiaries

Expected Impact

- Certified mechanical training
- Access to paid employment or entrepreneurship
- Self-managed community garage

# Saint Paul IV Vocational Training Center Project

## led by Fundación Pescar

Automotive mechanics training & employment integration

Partnership: 2015  
Rosario de Lerma, Argentina 🇦🇷  
Motul representative: Michel Rivoire

Fundación Pescar supports the professional integration of vulnerable young people through intensive training programs focused on technical professions and socio-professional skills, with the support of the municipality of Rosario de Lerma.

**Intensive training:** 42 active programs in 2024, delivered through a hybrid learning format;

**Professional integration:** Alumni support, scholarships, and interview simulations;

**Automotive mechanics:** San Pablo VI Training Center in Rosario de Lerma, supported by Motul Corazón for the past 10 years.

### Intervention model

The program combines:

- intensive technical, digital, and behavioral training;
- direct learning opportunities with partner companies;
- individualized follow-up;
- collaboration between companies, NGOs, and public stakeholders.

Its objective is to strengthen young people's independence, confidence, and long-term employability.

### Key figures

#### Social Impact

- 13,353 beneficiaries in 2024
- 883 young people enrolled in intensive training
- 836 graduates (5% dropout rate)

#### Programs & Partnerships

- 42 active Pescar Centers across Argentina
- 120+ partner companies supporting employment opportunities

- 92% training completion rate
- 70% continuation in education

# School of Mechanics Project

## led by the NGO Pour un Sourire d'Enfant (PSE)

Hybrid vehicle mechanics training & youth employment integration

Partnership: 2018  
Phnom Penh, Cambodia 🇰🇲  
Motul representative: Michel Rivoire

PSE supports extremely vulnerable children and young people affected by poverty, school dropout, abuse, or unsafe working conditions by providing access to care, education, and vocational training opportunities.

Within this framework, the School of Mechanics trains Cambodian youth in automotive maintenance and hybrid vehicle mechanics. Through a vocational program combining theory, hands-on workshop practice, and internships within partner companies, students acquire both the technical and interpersonal skills needed for long-term integration into the job market.

### Intervention model

The program is built around several key pillars:

- a two-year vocational training program in automotive mechanics;
- practical workshop-based learning and technical courses;
- development of soft skills (teamwork, communication);
- internships within partner companies.

The project aims to promote sustainable access to employment.

### Key figures

#### Training Program

- 97 students enrolled for the 2025–2026 academic year
- Two-year vocational training program
- 70% practical training and 30% theoretical learning

#### Professional Integration

- 91% of graduates found employment within 3 months after graduation
- 88% of graduates found employment within 12 months after graduation

#### Partnerships

- Internships carried out with 14 partner companies and automotive workshops



### Support from the Motul Corazón Foundation

The Motul Corazón Foundation supports PSE's School of Mechanics in order to strengthen students' technical training and improve learning conditions.

This partnership helps transmit professional skills related to mobility professions and promotes the sustainable professional integration of young people from disadvantaged backgrounds.

# Seeds of Hope Project led by IECD

Empowering young people through inclusive automotive training in Vietnam

Partnership: 2023

Hồ Chí Minh City, Vietnam 🇻🇳

Motul representative: Lionel Dantiacq and his team

The Seeds of Hope project, led by the Institut Européen de Coopération et de Développement (IECD), aims to provide disadvantaged young people in Vietnam with access to qualified technical training in automotive maintenance.

Implemented in partnership with the public technical school DTTEC (District Technical and Economic College) in Ho Chi Minh City, the program seeks to strengthen the quality of vocational education and develop the technical and professional skills required for long-term integration into the job market.

## Intervention model

This innovative hybrid training program is based on several actions:

- short technical training combined with paid internships in companies;
- strengthening of training programs;
- teacher training;
- career guidance and professional integration activities.

The objective is to better align training with labor market needs and facilitate access to sustainable qualified employment for young people.

## Key figures

### Training Program

- Young people aged 17 to 25
- 200+ students supported each year
- One automotive maintenance stream covering several professions, including mechanical maintenance, bodywork, and automotive painting
- One partner public technical school: DTTEC

### Professional Integration

- Development of technical and soft skills
- Career guidance activities, company visits, and internships

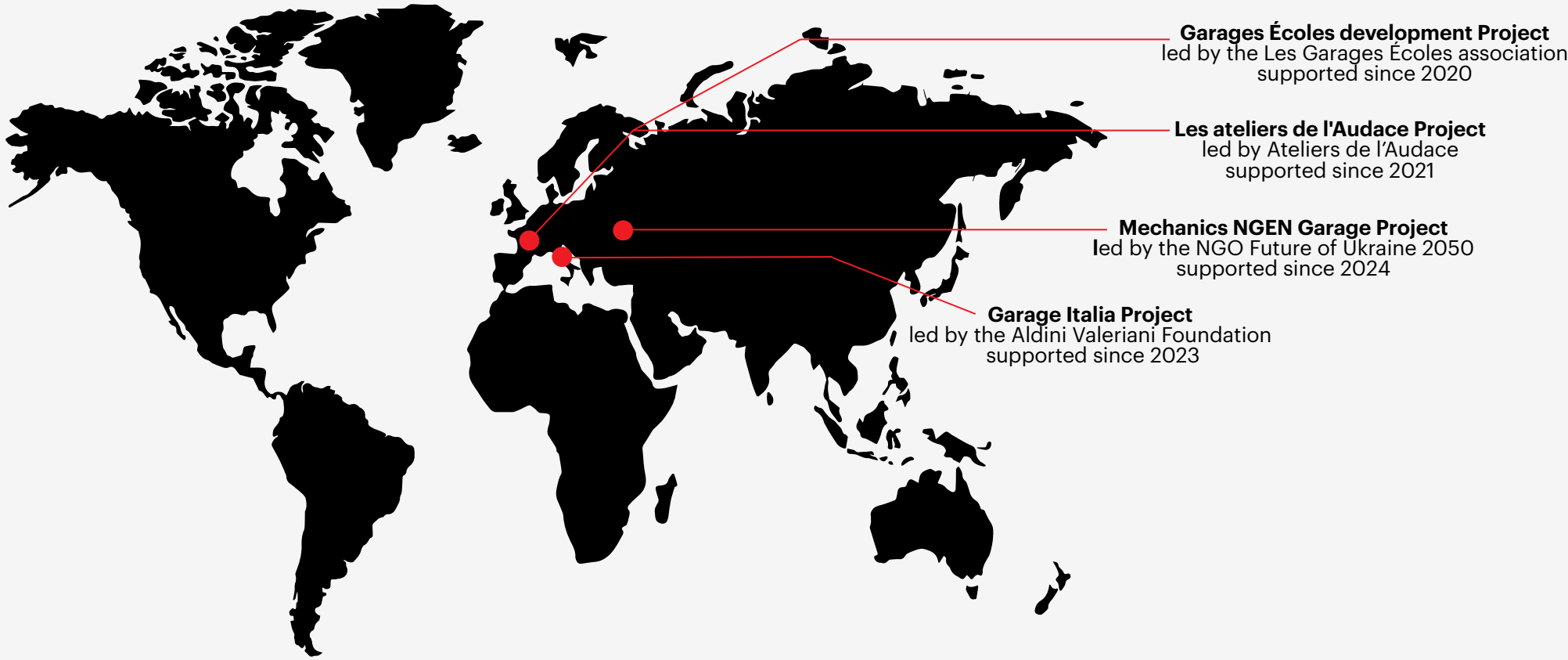

## Support from the Motul Corazón Foundation

The Motul Corazón Foundation, together with highly committed local teams, supports the consolidation of the training program and the strengthening of skills development. The Foundation's financial support contributes to funding bodywork workshop equipment and covering living costs for students in training. It also helps strengthen teachers' educational skills, support company visits, and develop initiatives promoting the professional integration of beneficiaries, with strong involvement from local teams.

# Garages Écoles development Project

led by the Les Garages Écoles association

Professional integration & training in automotive mechanics

Partnership: 2020

France 

Motul representative: Hélène Zaugg

Led by the Les Garages Écoles association, this project supports young people aged 15 to 18 facing academic difficulties toward professional integration in automotive mechanics trades.

Created through the initiative of Motul, Norauto, Movom, Crédit Agricole For Youth, and the Fédération Nationale des Écoles de Production, the association is developing a network of schools based on hands-on pedagogy closely aligned with real industry conditions.

## Intervention model

The project follows the Écoles de Production model, based on the principle of “learning by doing”: students are trained through real-life situations by working on customers’ vehicles within the school garage itself. The curriculum combines general education and technical training over a three-year period. This model offers an alternative pathway to traditional vocational education programs, particularly suited to young people facing school dropout or academic challenges, by providing a practical, empowering, and employment-oriented environment.

## Key figures

### Training Program

- Young people aged 15 to 18
- Diploma pathway (CAP, vocational high school diploma)
- Training in real garage conditions
- 8 School Garages currently operating: Argentan, Dole, Le Mans, Lille, Orchies, Vaulx-en-Velin, and Viuz-en-Sallaz

### Deployment

- Objective: 15 schools within 10 years
- Up to 450 students trained each year



## Support from the Motul Corazón Foundation

The Motul Corazón Foundation supports the development of the School Garages network in order to promote young people’s professional integration within a high-demand sector. Its commitment contributes to structuring and expanding this innovative educational model through financial, human, and technical support, as well as through its network of industry stakeholders.

This partnership aims to provide young people with qualifying training, strengthen their confidence, and facilitate long-term access to employment in mechanical professions.

# Les Ateliers de l'Audace Project

## led by Les Ateliers de l'Audace association

Professional integration through bicycle mechanics  
& circular economy initiatives

Partnership: 2021

Métropole de Lyon, France 

Motul representative: Michel Rivoire

Les Ateliers de l'Audace is a Work Integration Social Enterprise (ACI) whose mission is to reduce inequalities in access to employment through bicycle mechanics trades. The association has developed a model based on three complementary pillars:

**Social:** supporting people far from employment toward long-term integration;

**Environmental:** promoting bicycle repair, reuse, and recycling;

**Economic:** providing accessible local services for all.

### Intervention model

The support program is based on:

- progressive technical training (diagnostics, repair, refurbishment, customer relations);
- individualized socio-professional support;
- real-life work situations;
- strong local partnerships with employment and mobility stakeholders.

Beyond learning a profession, the association aims to foster independence, self-confidence, and sustainable integration.

### Key figures

#### Social Impact

- 41 employees in integration pathways
- 17 new participants enrolled
- 10 young people integrated into the youth program

#### Inclusive Mobility

- 10 mobile workshops in priority neighborhoods
- 159 free repairs carried out
- 67 young people introduced to mechanics

#### Environmental Impact

- 1,500 bicycles collected and refurbished since launch
- 3,500 bicycles repaired
- 534 tons of CO<sub>2</sub> emissions avoided

# Garage Italia Project

## led by Fondazione Aldini Valeriani

Vocational training in automotive repair

Partnership: 2023

Bologna, Italy

Led by Fondazione Aldini Valeriani, the Garage Italia project offers vocational training in automotive repair.

The program is based on a learning environment closely reflecting real working conditions, allowing participants to develop technical skills through professional processes and hands-on experience.

This educational model aims to support skills development and the long-term professional integration of young people into the job market.

### Intervention model

The project is based on an experimental educational approach:

- practical learning within a school garage;
- real repair work carried out on vehicles;
- educational and professional support for participants alongside technical skills development.

This model enables young people to acquire practical skills directly applicable to the automotive repair sector.

### Key figures

First Edition Results

- 5 participants
- 4 entered the workforce
- 1 continuing vocational training

Beneficiaries

- 8 direct beneficiaries
- Young people aged 18–25

# Mechanics NGEN Garage Project

## led by the NGO Future of Ukraine 2050

Training in automotive mechanics professions

Partnership: 2024

Bar, Ukraine

The Mechanics NGEN Garage project, led by the organization Future of Ukraine 2050, aims to train a new generation of young mechanics in Ukraine.

In a context of economic reconstruction, the project provides a modern learning environment where young people acquire technical skills in automotive mechanics. Through access to professional equipment, participants develop essential know-how for integration into mobility-related professions.

### Intervention model

The initiative is based on several key areas:

- creation of a dedicated mechanics training space;
- hands-on learning using professional equipment;
- transmission of technical skills;
- preparation of young people for automotive maintenance professions.

The project aims to promote access to employment and technical skills development.

### Key figures

Equipment Funded

- Professional workstations for the workshop
- Diagnostic bench for starters and alternators
- Wrenches, power tools, and mechanical equipment

Deployment

- Creation of a fully equipped training space
- Operational mechanical workshop dedicated to youth training
